### Measurements:

- Evening Evergreen Card Stock: 4-1/4" x 5-1/2"
- Basic White Thick Card Stock: 2-3/4" X 4", 3-1/2" x 5"
- Cherry Cobbler Card Stock: scrap for branch of buds
- Misty Moonlight Card Stock: scrap for leaves
- Soft Succulent Card Stock: 2-1/2" x 5" for 2 stars
- Tidings of Christmas 6"x6" DSP: 2 pieces light coloured background: 4-1/2" x 5-1/4"; 1 piece of same light coloured background: 4" x 5-1/4"; 1 piece of dark background 2" x 4"

### Instructions:

1. Score both of the 4-1/2" x 5-1/4" pieces of DSP with the light-coloured background at 1/2" on one of the long edges. Crease the folds and add Stampin' Seal to the narrow panel of DSP. Tuck one of the narrow panels under the top and bottom edge of the 4" x 5-1/4" piece of DSP. In my project, I kept the same pattern of DSP as top side but it is your project, so decide which surface of the paper you wish to be visible.
2. Insert the bottom panel into your Paper Trimmer and cut from bottom left paper edge to the top right horizontal score mark (see video at FaceBook: Ink and Sparkle Stamping with Sue dated Sept 8, 2021 if desired).

## INK AND SPARKLE STAMPING

3. Add a thin strip of Stampin' Seal along the left short side of the pocket panel and fold up to seal.
4. Add Stampin' Seal to the back of the center panel of DSP and add to the center of the Evening Evergreen card stock.
5. Die cut a Scalloped stitched rectangle from the Basic White Thick Cardstock using the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> largest rectangle dies from the Scalloped Contour Dies.
6. Die cut 2 outline star shapes from Soft Succulent card stock from the Tidings & Trimmings Die set.
7. Using the same die set, cut a branch of buds shape from the scrap of Cherry Cobbler card stock and a set of small leaves from the scrap of Misty Moonlight and a loopy star from the Be Dazzling DSP.
8. Add adhesive in the middle of one of the Soft Succulent stars and adhere the 2 stars together. Roll several Mini Glue Dots and add to the back of the Be Dazzling star and add 2 more Mini Glue dots to the center of the scar.
9. Add the Be Dazzling star to the top of the Soft Succulent stars and add one large Cherry Cobbler Holiday Rhinestone to the middle of the star.
10. Add Stampin' Seal to the back of the Soft Succulent star and add the Misty Moonlight and Cherry Cobbler die cuts as desired.
11. Stamp your desired greeting to the left center of the smaller Basic White scalloped stitched rectangle, stamping off for a softer colour if desired.
12. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the star and adhere to the right side of the Basic White piece in Step #9 above.
13. Add Stampin' Seal to the back of the 2" x 4" piece of DSP and add to the center of the card front.
14. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the piece constructed in Step #10 and adhere to the center of the card front.
15. Take the larger rectangle die cut from the Basic White Card Stock and using Cherry Cobbler ink, stamp the greeting of your choice towards the left upper area of the rectangle. Use Soft Succulent ink to stamp a star image to the right of your greeting.
16. Add your personal greeting to the large rectangle in Step #14 and slide into the pocket on the inside of the card.
17. Stamp or add matching DSP to the flap or front of the envelope and give your beautiful project to someone special in your life.
