## Measurements:

- Real Red Card Stock: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4 along the long side, 1-1/2" x 3-3/4"
- Thick Basic White Card Stock: Cut 2 pieces at 4" x 5-1/4"
- Pear Pizzaz Card Stock: 2-3/4" x 3-1/2"
- Crumb Cake Card Stock: 3/4" x 3-1/4", plus a scrap for dog, cat or gerbil face
- Striped Pattern from DSP: 1" x 3-1/2" \* making sure stripe is horizontal (see picture)
- Linen Thread: 24"

## Instructions:

1. Using the pine boughs Embossing Folder, emboss the 1-1/2" x 3-3/4" piece of Real Red using the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine.
2. Stamp the larger striped Christmas stocking in Memento Black Ink onto the piece of Pear Pizzaz card stock, stamping just below centre.
3. Stamp the dog, cat or gerbil image onto the scrap of Crumb Cake card stock using Memento Black Ink.

## INK AND SPARKLE STAMPING

- Using the matching dies from the Stockings Dies included in the Bundle, die cut the large Christmas stocking and the pet face of your choice.
- Using the Crumb Cake Blends Markers, cover the animal face with the Light Blends marker and then use the Dark Blends Marker to add shadow marking as desired (see picture for dog). Use the Light Blends again to blend the ink. Add Wink of Stella to the nose of dog, whiskers of cat or gerbil (see video if desired for tips)
- Colour the lace top of the Christmas Stocking using the White Stampin' Chalk Maker. Let it dry well and then add Wink of Stella over the White Stampin' Chalk Marker.
- Adhere the embossed piece of Real Red Card Stock approximately 1/8" from the bottom of one of the Thick Basic White pieces of Card Stock.
- Adhere the striped piece of DSP above the Real Red piece, matching the left edges of both pieces.
- Adhere the Pear Pizzaz piece that you used to die cut the stocking, centered in the remaining space.
- Use regular Dimensionals to adhere the Christmas stocking back into the opening.
- Add regular Dimensionals to the back of the pet face and adhere so that the paws overlap onto the top of the Christmas stocking.
- Wrap the Linen Thread around the Thick Basic White panel about 1/4" from the top of the Real Red layer and tie a square knot to the far left side. Now tie a small bow with this same piece of Linen Thread and trim ends if needed (see picture for sizing of bow if desired).
- Stamp the "Christmas Greetings" image onto the 3/4" x 3-1/4" piece of Crumb Cake Card Stock.
- Add Mini Dimensionals to the back of the Crumb Cake greeting, avoiding the center lengthwise.
- Center the Crumb Cake layer so that the Linen Thread runs under the center of the Crumb Cake layer horizontally.
- Stamp the remaining piece of Thick Basic White Card Stocking using the additional greeting of your choice and Evening Evergreen Ink. Add 2 loopy leaves to the left of this greeting and adhere to the inside of the card.
- Add your personalized greeting and send to someone special in your life.
