- Pink sheet from Supple Shimmer 12" x 12" Specialty Paper (158068)

Accessories

- Stitched Rectangle Dies (151820)
- Stitched So Sweetly Dies (151690)
- White Baker's Twine from Essential Pack (155475)
- Light Petal Pink from Stampin' Blends Combo (154893)
- Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Measurements:

- Basic Black Cardstock: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4" on the long side
- Thick Basic White Cardstock: 2 pieces cut at 5-1/4" x 4" plus scrap for greeting
- Daffodil Afternoon DSP: 1" x 4-1/4" scraps of each of 4 patterns of your choice; 2-1/4" x 6" piece of pattern of your choice for envelope flap.
- Pink - Subtle Shimmer Paper: approx. 1-18/8" x 3-1/8" scrap
- White Baker's Twine: 20"

Instructions:

1. Die cut 2 panels from each of the 4 patterns of DSP using the smallest scalloped rectangle die in the Stitched So Sweetly Dies.
2. Die cut the piece of pink Supple Shimmer Specialty Paper using the 2nd smallest skinny rectangle from the Stitched Rectangle dies.
3. Use the Light Petal Pink Stampin' Blend to colour the 20" of White Baker's Twine. Set aside to dry.
4. Stamp the greeting on the scrap of Thick Basic White using Tuxedo Black Memento Ink.
5. Die cut the greeting using the smallest skinny rectangle die from the Stitched Rectangle dies.
6. Cut the coloured Baker's Twine in half and tie a double bow. Trim the ends if desired.
7. Use a ruler to help adhere the Daffodil Afternoon rectangles straight on the top & bottom areas of one of the 5-1/4" x 4" Thick Basic White panels using Multipurpose Liquid Glue (see picture).

8. Use Multipurpose Liquid Glue to adhere the pink Supple Shimmer paper in the middle of the panels (see picture).
9. Use Mini Glue Dots to adhere the greeting to the pink Subtle Shimmer paper.
10. Use Mini Glue Dots to adhere the bow to the top right corner of the pink Supple Shimmer paper.
11. Use Multipurpose Liquid Glue to adhere the Thick Basic White panel to the card front.
12. Use Multipurpose Liquid Glue to adhere the other piece of Thick Basic White cardstock to the inside of the card and stamp additional images or greetings of your choice.
13. Add Multipurpose Liquid Glue to the edges of the envelope flap and adhere the 2-1/4" x 6" panel of Daffodil Afternoon DSP. Turn upside down and trim excess.
14. Add your personalized greeting to the inside of the card and send your pretty project to someone to encourage their day!
