- Basic White Thick Cardstock (159229)
- Brushstroke 12" x 12" Specialty Paper (159250)

## Accessories

- Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)
- Rhinestone Basic Jewels (144220)
- Stamparatus (146276)
- Paper Trimmer (152392)

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## Measurements:

- Basic White Thick Card Stock: 7-1/4" x 4-1/4", 4-1/4" x 1-3/4", 4" x 2-1/2"
- Brushstroke Specialty DSP: 2 pieces cut at 4" x 1-1/2"  
(Night of Navy colour)

## Instructions:

1. Score the card base (7-1/4" x 4-1/4" at 5-1/2" along the long side and crease the fold well.
2. Using Multipurpose Liquid Glue, glue one Night of Navy Brushstroke DSP pieces to the 4-1/4" x 1-3/4" piece of Thick Basic White card stock.
3. Position the 4" x 2-1/2" piece of Thick Basic White card stock on the Stamparatus, making sure piece aligns nicely on the grid paper.
4. Position the Mary, Joseph & Jesus stamp, rubber facedown, centered on the piece of card stock.
5. Swing the acrylic plate from the Stamparatus onto the cling side of the stamp so that you pick up the stamp onto the acrylic plate.
6. Swing the acrylic plate back towards your table surface and place your stamp set under the plate. When you add your ink, this makes it easy to get good ink coverage by doing this little step!

7. Add Night of Navy Ink to the rubber side of the stamp and swing the Stamparatus acrylic plate back towards your piece of Thick Basic White card stock and stamp the image. Reink the stamp if needed to get a really good and dark image on the card stock.
8. Clean the stamp and remove from the Stamparatus.
9. Colour the star image with the Dark Daffodil Delight Blends Marker.
10. Add a tiny Rhinestone Basic Jewel to the center of the star.
11. Add the remaining panel of Night of Navy Brushstroke DSP to the top 4-1/4" x 1-3/4" scored panel of the card base.
12. Close the card base and position the Brushstroke panel you glued onto thick Basic White card stock in Step #2 at the bottom of the card base (see picture and/or video on FaceBook for more info if required).
13. Add Stampin' Dimensionals ONLY to the points and corners on the back of the stamped panel.
14. Remove the backings from the Stampin' Dimensionals and carefully position the stamped panel so that bottom adheres to the bottom panel in Step #12 and the top of the stamped panel adheres to the top of the card front.
15. Stamp the greeting of your choice in the window area to the right of the stamped panel.
16. This Fancy Fold is called a Split Panel Card - I hope you enjoy using the tutorial and sending/giving great cards to friends and family. Don't forget to let me know on FaceBook if you've changed up the design and make alternate projects with the tutorial -- I'd love to see what you do!
